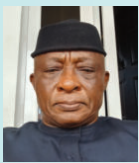

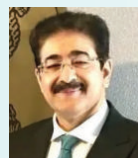

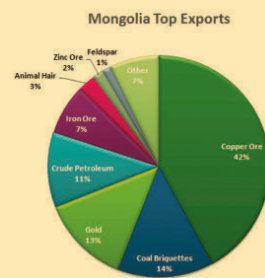

MAURITIUS' GAINS: PREFERENTIAL MARKET ACCESS

Mauritius stands to gain preferential market access to India on 615 products, including duty-free treatment for 376 items and reduced duties on 127. Noteworthy are the Tariff Rate Quotas for products like special sugar, beer, rum, and fruit wine, symbolizing a deeper level of collaboration. The agreement also bolsters trade in goods such as garments, canned tuna, medical devices, and tropical fruits, amplifying Mauritius' economic potential.

INDIA'S RECIPROCITY: EXPANDING MARKET HORIZONS

In reciprocity, India extends preferential access to Mauritius on 310 products, spanning a range from spices and tea to plastic articles and wooden furniture. This commitment to extending preferential access highlights the shared resolve to cultivate bilateral trade ties further.

UNLOCKING SERVICE SECTOR POTENTIAL

The CECPA places a strong emphasis on services, offering Indian service providers access to around 115 sub-sectors in Mauritius. This encompasses

professional services, telecommunications, tourism, and more. The reverse also holds true, signifying the wide-ranging opportunities within the services sector.

SAFEGUARDING SENSITIVE INTERESTS

A noteworthy inclusion in the agreement is the Automatic Trigger Safeguard Mechanism (ATSM) for sensitive products. This pragmatic approach by both nations ensures a balanced and equitable trade relationship while protecting domestic industries.

BEYOND TRADE: COLLABORATIVE ENDEAVORS

The CECPA's economic cooperation chapter transcends trade, setting the stage for joint strategies across 25 key areas. These areas encompass manufacturing, pharmaceuticals, ICT, and the blue economy, among others. This holistic approach signifies a shared vision for sustainable growth and development.

ADHERING TO GUIDELINES FOR SUCCESS



To maximize the benefits of the CECPA, participants must adhere to rules of origin requirements and provide necessary certificates. This ensures a transparent and mutually beneficial trade environment, promoting a level playing field.

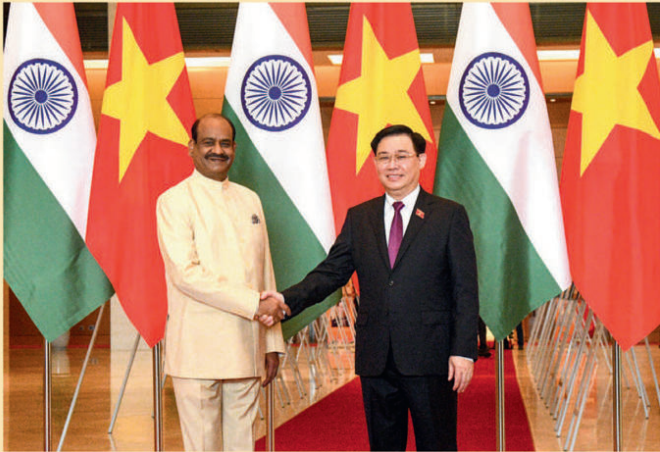
